### Spring Dinner/Silent Auction

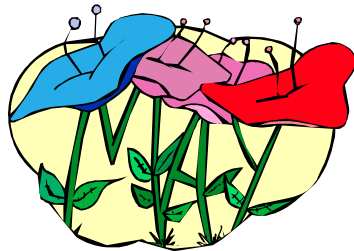
Mark your calendars! Guiding Shepherd's annual dinner and auction will be on Saturday, April 29.
